NAMI Pensacola provides support and education for the family and friends of individuals living with mental illness, giving a voice to those who seek a path to enhanced services. We also offer support and advocate for those in our community who suffer. Currently one in four Americans are impacted by mental illness, and one in twenty by severe mental illness. Many do not seek treatment because of the **stigma** attached to this devastating disease and many do not know where to turn.

A grass-roots, non-profit corporation, **NAMI Pensacola** is staffed entirely by volunteers, and all donations are tax deductible. Our programs are **free** to the public. We offer four meetings per month; a **Family Support Meeting** and an **Educational Meeting** for the family and friends of individuals living with mental illness; and two meetings of the **Connection Recovery Support Group** for those with a lived experience of mental illness. We also offer the 12-week **Family to Family Education** course in the early spring and fall each year.

Funds raised by the **NAMI Pensacola Walk** in 2017 enabled us to send two members to **NAMI Connection** training and one member to **NAMI Smarts Advocacy** training. This year, we hope to add **NAMI Peer to Peer**, **NAMI Provider Education** and **NAMI In Our Own Voice**.

But more importantly, we seek to raise awareness of the plight of our friends and loved ones living so bravely with mental illness. Underserved, misunderstood and at the bottom of the totem pole in terms of public dollars allocated for research and cutting-edge treatment, our friends and loved ones deserve better. The state of Florida is 50th in the nation in terms of mental health funding. This is your opportunity to add your voice to those calling for change.

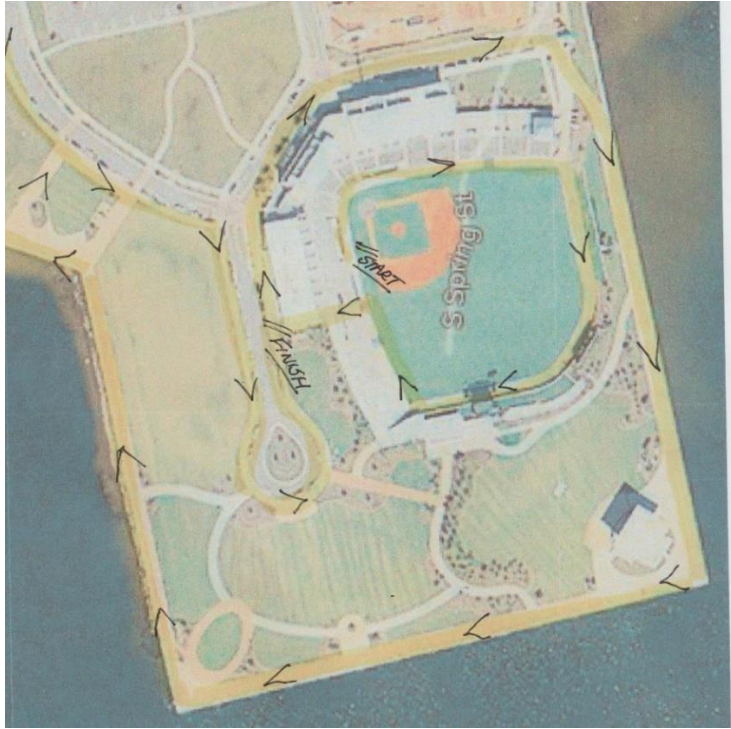
